

## Anonymous Grant 2006 Awards

- \$4,450      Watoto Village Youth Ministries  
Cherry Hill Presbyterian Church  
To provide a safe, nurturing atmosphere for the disadvantaged youth of Cherry Hill and surrounding communities in Westport, Mt. Winans and Brooklyn. This is a place where youth can learn, engage intellectually and creatively, socialize and pursue spiritual activities to help them to grow into productive responsible adults.
- \$8,000      Home Assistance for Neighbors in Need  
First Presbyterian of Westminster  
In an ecumenical partnership with six other congregations, provide materials, supplies and equipment needed for assistance and social support of about 150 home-bound adults in Carroll County.
- \$5,000      Aberdeen Outreach Ministries  
Grove Presbyterian Church  
An ecumenical partnership with ten other congregations uniting with Christ-like compassion to serve those who face emergencies such as utility cut offs, hunger, transportation needs and homelessness.
- \$2,000      Brown Memorial/Eutaw-Marshburn Reading Enrichment Project  
Brown Memorial Park Avenue  
In partnership with Eutaw-Marshburn Elementary School, provide books and dictionaries to each student at the school to compliment an existing tutoring program which has thrived for 42 years.
- \$5,000      Resource & Day Center for the Homeless in Anne Arundel County  
Woods Memorial, Harundale, First Presbyterian of Annapolis  
The Resource & Day Center will complement and support the Arundel House of Hope ministry by providing a central location for improving support services to people experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless. It will also serve as the intake center during Winter Relief Emergency Shelter season. Supportive services planned include information and referral for health care, employment, education, support groups, case management and day time respite.
- \$3,000      Caring and Sharing Ministry  
Taneytown United Presbyterian Church  
In ecumenical partnership with eight other congregations, CSM will provide for community needs, transportation vouchers, sponsor Community Vacation Bible School and a Community Block Party and will offer a weekly Carpenter's Table Community Meal.
- \$200        Operation C.A.R.E.S. for Kids

Harundale Presbyterian Church  
Crocheted Afghans Reaching Extra Special creates blankets to be distributed to children in the Baltimore County Foster Care program, Eutaw Oncology Center, Transplant Resource Center, Sarah's House and Anne Arundel Medical Center Emergency Department.

\$12,800 Shepherd's Kids + Transformed Lives, Family, World  
Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church

This project will provide children in our community tutoring that is affordable, convenient, accessible and quality in such a way that it will support students to reach higher levels of achievement in school. This program will make resources available to struggling learners and those with special needs. It will be available at no or low cost based on application. Proactive support will be provided to parents to help them to help their children excel.

\$8,750 Parenting Plus

Support for a parenting program at Sarah's Hope Outreach Center that would provide parents with the tools to raise emotionally, socially, educationally and cognitively developed children while coping with the realities of living in a transitional situation.
